

MSEA DELEGATE ASSEMBLY

Delegate Selection

The number of delegates for each school district/bargaining unit shall be determined based on the number of members employed by the district on March 1 of each year. To be eligible to serve as a delegate, a person must be a member of MSEA in good standing with full membership privileges.

School Districts with one MSEA Bargaining Unit

shall be entitled to not fewer than two (2) delegates. Any unit that employs more than 75 MSEA members may select one (1) additional delegate for every 75 members over the initial 75 members.

Less than 150 full members	2 delegates
150 full members	3 delegates
225 full members	4 delegates
300 full members	5 delegates
375 full members	6 delegates

School Districts with more than one MSEA Bargaining Unit

may choose between the following two options (whichever yields the greatest number of delegates).

Option 1: These Bargaining Units may agree to combine their full membership numbers and use the formula listed above.

Option 2: Each Bargaining Units shall be entitled to not fewer than one (1) delegate per bargaining unit. Any Bargaining Unit that employs more than 75 MSEA members may select one (1) additional delegate for every 75 members over the initial 75 members. Individual Bargaining Unit delegates are transferable to other Bargaining Units within the same School District at the discretion of the individual bargaining unit.

Less than 150 full members	1 delegate
150 full members	2 delegates
225 full members	3 delegates
300 full members	4 delegates
375 full members	5 delegates
